Zoom

Cost: Varies, ranges from \$15 to 155+
Max # of Participants: 500/webinar, 100 meetings
Format: Livestream/webinar, video conference
Pros: High quality, easy to use
Cons: Time limit, need account or app to use, possible security issues

YouTube Live

Cost: Free
Max # of Participants: Unlimited
Format: Livestream
Pros: Can be public or private
Cons: Must have YouTube channel to stream, requirements for mobile streaming

Skype Video

Cost: Free
Max # of Participants: 50
Format: Video conference
Pros: Encrypted, offers subtitles
Cons: Must have account

Facebook Live

Cost: Free
Max # of Participants: Unlimited
Format: Livestream
Pros: People can view livestream without having a Facebook account
Cons: Video quality can be slow or less high-res than other platforms, must have account to stream
